



# Participant Dashboard Glossary

## People by current eligibility status

This pie chart shows the number of people who were ever eligible in the NDIS and those who were found ineligible. Note that the number of eligible people includes participants who were found eligible but are no longer active in the scheme.

## Eligible participants by access type

This pie chart shows the number of NDIS participants who were ever eligible, broken down by the manner in which the participant accessed the scheme.

- Whether the participant is part of an early intervention program (Early intervention) or not (Disability)
- Whether the participant was previously in a state or commonwealth funded program (Existing) or not (New)

## Approved plans by month

This bar chart shows the number of plans by month approved. It is further broken down depending on whether it is the first plan for the participant or from a subsequent plan review. The month of approval is shown on the horizontal axis and number of plans on the vertical axis.

## Approved plans for participants by age group

This pie chart shows the number of NDIS participants with approved plans by age band.

## Approved plans for participants by primary disability (%)

This bar chart shows the distribution of participants with approved plans by primary disability type. The primary disability category is shown on the vertical axis and the proportion is shown on the horizontal axis.

Note that the primary disability categories are chosen in line with external reports where disability types are grouped into one of the following:

- Autism And Related Disorders
- Cerebral Palsy
- Deafness/Hearing Loss
- Developmental Delay
- Down Syndrome
- Global Developmental Delay
- Intellectual Disability
- Multiple Sclerosis
- Schizophrenia
- Other Intellectual/learning



- Other Neurological
- Other Physical
- Other Psychiatric
- Other Sensory/Speech

### **Approved plans for participants by management type**

This pie chart shows the number of participants with approved plans, broken down by the way that the plan is managed. Plans can be managed by the agency, self-managed by participants, managed by a plan management provider, or a combination of these.

Note that the report to the COAG Disability Reform Council has a similar chart. The figures will not match because this chart shows all participants who have approved plans, while the chart in the report shows only active participants with approved plans.

### **Proportion of participants with an approved plan**

This bar chart shows the number of culturally and linguistically diverse (CALD) participants and Indigenous participants as a proportion of the total number of participants with an approved plan.

### **Approved plans for participants by cost band**

This bar chart shows the total number of plans ever approved, broken down by the annualised cost of the plan. The annualised cost band is shown on the horizontal axis and the number of plans is shown on the vertical axis.

### **Approved funded support by category**

This bar chart shows the cost of all approved funded supports, broken down by the category of funded support. The largest eleven categories are shown and the remaining categories are grouped together in the 'Other' category. The funded support type category is shown on the vertical axis and the total cost is shown on the horizontal axis.

### **Committed support by age band**

This bar chart shows the cost of all approved funded supports, broken down by the age of participant. The age band is shown on the horizontal axis and the total cost of committed supports is shown on the vertical axis.

### **Average annualised plan statistics**

This text describes the distribution of annualised cost of current plans. The mean, median and 25<sup>th</sup> and 75<sup>th</sup> percentiles of annualised cost are quoted. Note that these figures exclude participants in the Stockton, Kanangra and Colanda large residential centres.
